My dear Parents, Teachers and Students



Plants are the important part of nature. They are very useful to us and we get many things from plants.




Here we have our kids saving the plants by watering them.

A NEW RECIPE THAT I LEARNT

Mickey Mouse Pancake

Ingredients:
1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
3 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
1 1/4 cups milk
3 tablespoons butter, melted
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon sugar
1 egg

Directions:
In a large bowl, sift together the flour, baking powder, salt and sugar. Make a well in the center and pour in the milk, egg and melted butter; mix until smooth.
Heat a lightly oiled griddle or frying pan over medium-high heat. Pour or scoop the batter onto the griddle, using approximately 1/4 cup for each pancake. Brown on both sides and serve hot.

Preparation: 12 Minutes
Cooking: 5 Minutes


