

We welcome you to the second edition of PMS CANVAS 2020-21, a priceless slice of work brought to you by our budding artists.


This edition of the E Magazine was made possible due to the immense support and guidance given to us by our management.

We appreciate your constant support and hope you enjoy this magazine as much as we enjoyed putting it together.



## *Activities Galore*



HAPPY INDEPENDENCE DAY








## *Cleanliness*

A clean home is a happy home.


Awareness of the cleanliness and personal hygiene is the need of the hour. Our tiny tots of PMS showed us how to remain healthy and hygienic through various ways.








## *Rainy Season*



# FANCY DRESS COMPETITION


An online Fancy Dress Competition was initiated for nursery children. The kids were enthusiastic as online competition for them was a new concept.
