






SEA ANIMALS


DOMESTIC ANIMALS



He started schools and social service centres to realize the above mentioned virtues. He taught us to trust in God and live in peace and happiness.








TEACHER'S DAY

Christmas is celebrated on 25th December all over the world. This festival is to rejoice the Birth of Jesus Christ.


